# Cold En Bloc Resection of Large Residual Tissue Using the CoinTip<sup>™</sup> snare

#### **Procedure:**

En bloc removal of residual tissue by cold snare polypectomy.

#### Indications:

A patient was returning for a surveillance colonoscopy after a previous endoscopic mucosal resection (EMR) where a large polyp was found.

#### **Treatment:**

Upon colonoscopy, a 16mm polyp was found at the previous EMR site. The CoinTip snare was able to grasp the polyp in its entirety and provided an en bloc resection. There was no need for injection or diathermic energy.




Fig. 1: Residual polyp tissue with and without NBI prior to resection




Fig. 2: Clean resection site with the CoinTip snare
